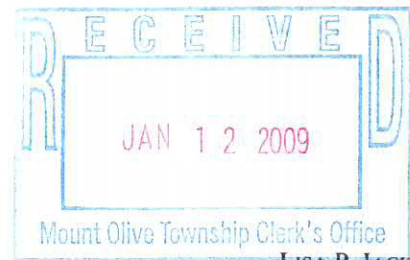

This letter is with reference to your December 3, 2008 lettered requesting an extension of time for the submission of a completed Dam Safety Permit Application package for the permanent breaching or rehabilitation of the Morris County YMCA Dam located within Mount Olive Township, Morris County.

The Mt. Olive Complex Inc. is hereby granted a time extension until **March 31, 2009** to submit the Dam Safety Permit Application for the permanent removal or the rehabilitation of the Morris County YMCA Dam, in compliance with the New Jersey Dam Safety Standards (N.J.A.C. 7:20-1.7(h)) provided that the lake surface elevation will be maintained at a reduced elevation until the permit is approved and construction is undertaken. Should any further delays arise, this office should be notified immediately and a written request for an extension of time submitted.

Please note that an application must be filed with this office and a permit issued before any additional repairs or modifications are undertaken.
