

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF WILLIAM SOHL AS
BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, Mayor David Scapicchio on November 13, 2006 appointed Mr. William Sohl as the Business Administrator as an interim appointment in accordance with M.O.T. Administrative Code Article II, Section 4-8; and

WHEREAS, the Mount Olive Township Council did confirm/consent to that appointment by resolution in January 2, 2007 for the remainder of the mayor's term of office to Dec 31, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the mayor has put forth William Sohl for reappointment to the position of Business Administrator, subject to consent of the governing body according to NJSA 40:69A; and


WHEREAS, conditions of the original appointment should be restated for the term of the reappointment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, does hereby consent to the reappointment of William Sohl as the business Administrator retroactively effective to January 1, 2008; and ending December 31, 2011 at an annual salary of \$105,000 or as otherwise increased by future salary ordinances, without severance pay, without a car allowance, without medical and dental insurance, with a cell phone allowance of \$40.00 per month, with vacation at the rate of 1 2/3 days per month, and with all other benefits as otherwise provided in the Employee Management Handbook.
