

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL MATERIALS AND
EQUIPMENT FOR CONTINUED STABILIZATION OF THE SEWARD HOUSE**

WHEREAS, the Township is the owner of a historic mansion known as the Seward House and the status of this house is that a Certificate of Eligibility for the National Register of Historic Places has been issued; and

WHEREAS, the structure has been inspected by qualified architects and/or engineers who have determined that the structure is in need of continued stabilization; and

WHEREAS, recent discovery of some conditions require additional materials prior to the completion of the roof can be replacement, and

WHEREAS, the Township has funds available from the Open Space Trust Fund for the stabilization of this building which will require additional building materials and equipment rental not to exceed \$5,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the work needs to begin immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize equipment rentals and building materials to be purchased by the Township at a price not to exceed \$5,000.
