

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE APPROVING NJDOT PLANS TO REMOVE A TRAFFIC
ISLAND FROM VILLAGE WAY ENTRANCE TO VILLAGE GREEN FOR
SAFETY AND TRAFFIC REASONS**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) has for several years investigated the need to improve safety and traffic flow conditions at the intersection of Village Way (the eastern entrance/egress to the Village Green complex) and US Route 46 in Mount Olive Township; and

WHEREAS, after such investigation by the NJDOT it has been recommended by the NJDOT that the traffic island in the Village Way entrance road to Village Green be removed as per their letter and plans dated May 20, 2008 sent to Gene Buczynski, Township Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT plans have been reviewed by the Township Engineer, Administration and Planning and deemed to be acceptable and a needed safety improvement; and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT plans have also been provided by the Administration to the management of Village Green (aka Segal & Segal), reviewed by same; and

WHEREAS, Village Green management has now provided their acceptance of the NJDOT plan via fax on November 6, 2008 to the Township by Tom Kretsch, Director of Property Management; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT has requested a formal concurring resolution by the governing body in support of the NJDOT plans.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby approve the NJDOT plans to remove the Village Way island as a matter of safety and traffic improvement.
