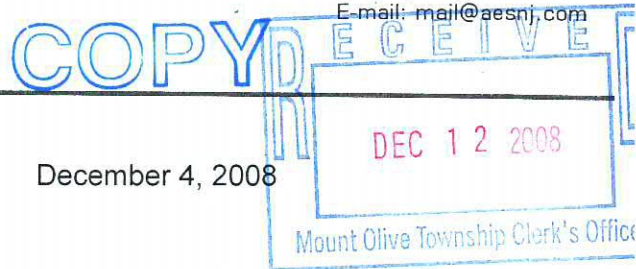

Enclosed please find the Biennial Certification Monitoring Report for the Classification Exception Area (CEA) at the above referenced site.

Ground water sampling performed in 2007 had shown no elevated compounds remaining at the site and a 'Final Remedial Action Report' dated August 21, 2007 was submitted. The report included a request to lift the CEA. While awaiting a response from the DEP, the site wells were sampled on October 24, 2008, as part of a possible property purchase. One (1) well showed slightly elevated MTBE levels and therefore it is requested that the CEA remain in place.

Also enclosed is a check (#45882) in the amount of \$ 375 made payable to "Treasurer, State of New Jersey". The enclosed CD contains the report as an Adobe Acrobat file and the floppy disk (NJDEP only) includes the laboratory data in the required electronic format.
