

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE ENDORSING ASSEMBLY
BILL A-3570**

WHEREAS, all municipalities within the State of New Jersey have suffered considerably from the edicts issued by COAH over the last 20 years; and

WHEREAS, these edicts have become more and more life threatening for municipalities in New Jersey in terms of being able to facilitate and accommodate new development; and

WHEREAS, the edicts issued by COAH are now being challenged on a number of fronts on the basis that the Third Round allocations by COAH are not based upon realistic studies and are based upon whims of the Commissioners of COAH, all of which has increased the cost to the municipalities to defend their rights and to defend against onerous allocations of affordable units; and

WHEREAS, Assemblymen Merkt and Biondi have recently filed Assembly Bill A-3570, the purpose of which is to abolish an administrative agency that has not served the people of New Jersey and has not achieved the results for which it was created.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that it does hereby endorse Assembly Bill A-3570 and seeks its full adoption by the Assembly.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution shall be sent to all legislators representing any portion of Morris County..
