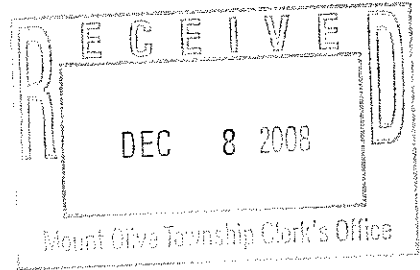

FIRST COUNT



JURY DEMAND


