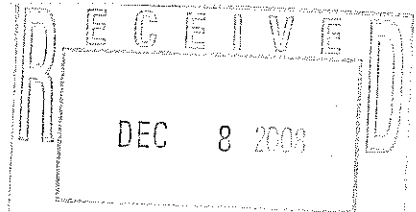

RESOLUTION RE: REVISING THE SOLID WASTE FACILITIES FY2009 SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES AND CHARGES (AMENDMENT NO.2)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 Et. Seq. requires that every Authority shall prescribe and, from time to time when necessary, revise a schedule of all its service charges; and

WHEREAS, the SCMUA Board of Commissioners did hold a Public Hearing and revised the SCMUA Schedule of Rates, Fees and Charges, as per the statute requirements on November 5, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the SCMUA Board of Commissioners have determined, based on recommendation by the Authority Administrator, Solid Waste Superintendent and Consulting Engineer, that administrative changes in the Rates and Fees charged be adjusted in response to the continuing lack of solid waste flow control regulatory authority, to be both competitive with out of County/State solid waste and recycling facilities, and to maximize revenues in an attempt to keep the solid waste facilities self-supporting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SCMUA Board of Commissioners have determined the following rates, fees and charges are to be utilized:

<u>SOLID WASTE CLASSIFICATION</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>FEE</u>
ID 702C	Clean Commingled Recyclables	\$35/ton
ID 702C	Class A Recyclables Commingled	\$10/minimum scale charge
ID 703	Class A Fiber	\$10/minimum scale charge

All other SCMUA rates, fees and charges shall remain unaffected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that self generators of Class A Recyclables are not required to utilize the scale system and pay for disposal of their recyclables. Anyone requiring a receipt shall be subject to disposal charges.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective December 8, 2008.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be distributed to all Sussex County solid waste haulers, municipalities and to the Board of Chosen Freeholders, and be posted for public display at the scale houses and Residents' Convenience Center.
