

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING A DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR
DONATIONS TO SUPPORT THE MUNICIPAL BEACH**

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:5-29 provides that a municipality may dedicate certain revenues in any budget when the character of the revenue is not subject to reasonable accurate estimate in advance by including in said budget a statement dedicating such revenues to the purpose or purposes for which they are received; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received a donation to be set aside for support of the municipal beach; and

WHEREAS, these funds shall be used for expenses attributable to the municipal beach.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of NJ, that donations/contributions received for the municipal beach are hereby dedicated and shall be made available for expenditures for the purposes stated above as and when received in cash during the fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Township Council that two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
