

ORD. #24-2008

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE MAKING
THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 39 APPLICABLE TO
THE BUDD LAKE FIRST AID & RESCUE SQUAD
PARKING LOT**

WHEREAS, the President of the Budd Lake First Aid & Rescue Squad, Phyllis Gentile, has requested enforcement of Title 39 regulations in the parking lot of the Rescue Squad Building and submitted a site plan detailing the parking areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. No person who is not a member of the Budd Lake First Aid & Rescue Squad shall park any vehicle on Lot 1, Block 7701 except when the First Aid Squad's building is being used for a civic function such as an election and such other public activities as designated by the First Aid & Rescue Squad.

SECTION 2. Signs prohibiting parking shall be posted on the lot in accordance with the current manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27.

SECTION 3. Violations shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both, as well as the owner paying any charges for towing and the impounding of vehicles.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Township's Police Department and cars may be towed with the expense for towing and storage to be paid by the owner before release of any impounded vehicle.

SECTION 5. If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption and the posting of signage indicating the parking restriction.
