**Subject: Waterloo Road Bridge over the Musconetcong River**

Dear Councilman Tobey:

The Morris County Department of Public Works, Division of Engineering is studying the replacement of the Waterloo Bridge over the Musconetcong River between the Borough of Stanhope in Sussex County and the Borough of Netcong and Township of Mt. Olive in Morris County.

In response to comments from the public on earlier bridge replacement alternatives, Jacobs Engineering and Richard Grubb Associates have worked with Morris County Engineering to develop an alternative that satisfies the project purpose and need for a safe vehicular crossing at this location, while seeking to minimize any resulting impacts to the character of the surrounding neighborhood.

The Morris County Division of Engineering is inviting you to a Public Meeting to provide further information on the proposed project, answer your questions, and obtain your feedback. The meeting will be held on Monday, March 15, 2010 from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at the Stanhope Borough Municipal Building, located at 77 Main Street in the Borough of Stanhope, Sussex County, NJ. Your comments on the proposed project are welcome, and you will have an opportunity to add them to the project at this meeting.

The March 15 Public Meeting will also fulfill the requirements of Section 106 of the Historic Preservation Act as it pertains to this project.
