

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP  
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE  
2010 TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Mandatory Source Separation Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for such tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and to indicate the assent of the Township of Mount Olive to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is promptly completed and timely filed; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey State Legislature has provided funding in the current state Fiscal 2010 budget;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that the Township of Mount Olive hereby endorses the submission of the 2010 Recycling Tonnage Grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and designates Tim Quinn, DPW Director to ensure that the 2010 application is properly filed; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the monies received from the Recycling Tonnage Grant be deposited in a dedicated Recycling Trust Fund.
