Central Jersey Invasive Species Strike Team

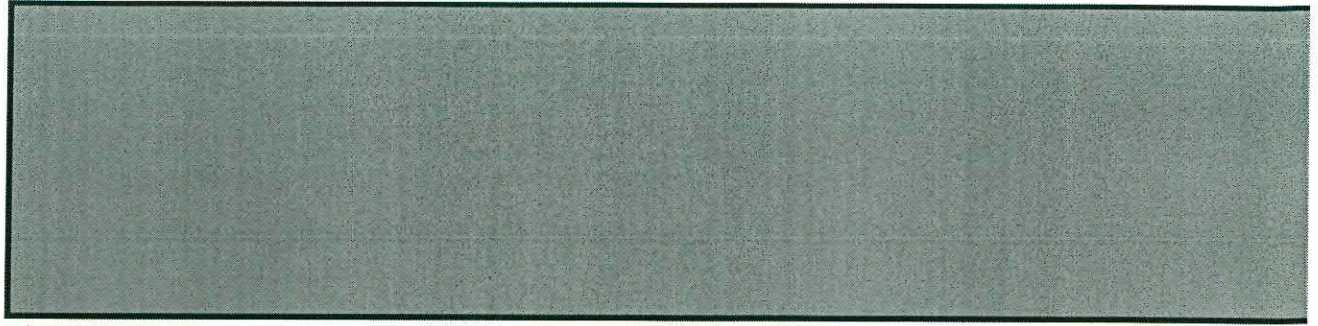
