Dear Mr. Jones:

Your application dated January 20, 2010 and received on February 3, 2010 was deemed to be administratively complete on February 9, 2010. During the technical review of the application, it was determined that additional information will be necessary for the Department of Environmental Protection (Department), Bureau of Watershed Regulation to complete the Highlands Applicability and Water Quality Management Plan Consistency Determination review.

The application includes a request for an exemption under N.J.A.C. 7:38-2.3(a)6, for any improvement, for non-residential purposes, to a place of worship owned by a non-profit entity, society or association, or association organized primarily for religious purposes, or a public or private school, or a hospital, in existence on August 10, 2004.

The items required for further review are listed below:

- As stated in Section IV. of the application, submit a letter from the waste treatment facility verifying the existence and extent of wastewater collection infrastructure on August 10, 2004, and that adequate capacity is available, with a written commitment to service the proposed project.
- Submit documentation, preferably the Treatment Works Approval (TWA) for the approved sewer line, showing when the sewer line was approved and constructed.
- Submit a letter from the township stating when the church building on the property was constructed and how long the Mountaintop Assembly of God Church has resided in that building.
- In a phone conversation with Luther Van Pelt, we discussed that the Mountain Top Assembly of God Church was previously known as a different name. Please supply official documentation verifying the previous name and location of the church. Also, please specify whom the New Jersey Council of the Assemblies of God is and there association with the Mountaintop Assembly of God Church.

A copy of the submittal that you send in response to this letter, as well as supporting information, must also be sent to those parties listed at N.J.A.C. 7:38-9.2(b)5.

Please be advised that you have 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter to submit the information required above. If after 30 days the required information is not submitted or fails to satisfy the deficiencies listed above, you will be issued a determination based on the information included in your current application, which may result in a Not Exempt determination. Please include a copy of this letter with the additional required information that you submit.
