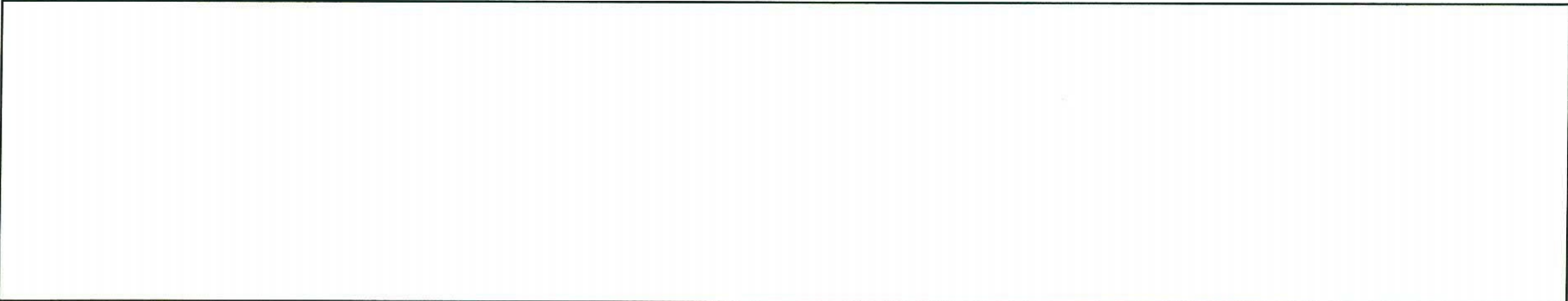

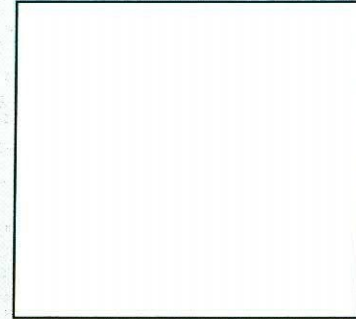
Jazzfest kicks off with a free concert on Friday, June 4 at 7:00 p.m. featuring the top New Jersey high school jazz bands.
