**Communications concerning JCP&L utilities in reference to: Variances, Subdivision, Acquisition, Expansion of or the Development of Property**

Issues have arisen due to residents and businesses encroaching on the clearances between their building and the power companies facilities. Specifically, customers have enlarged their building in height or depth and thereby reduced the clearance between the high voltage wires and their structure. This reduces the safety distance and increases the risk of property damage, injury or possibly death.

The National Electric Safety Code (NESC) has defined these minimum distances. JCP&L/FE Company Policies and Procedures mirror these requirements. Additional restrictions by the National Electric Code (NEC) and Organization Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) may also pertain.

There are numerous scenarios, which can transgress standard clearances. JCP&L/FE should be contacted when clearances to the wires are a concern. The Customer Service Center can be called at 1-800-662-3115 and your concerns can be investigated. JCP&L/FE personnel can advise customers early in the process on the required minimum clearances.

Occasionally, customers do not plan for these clearances in their project work scope. After construction is completed the customers recognize the proximity of the wires as a potential hazard and they request JCP&L/FE relocate the facilities due to the safety issue. If relocation is a possibility, the customer will be billed to modify the electrical construction. If relocation is not possible, the customer will be required to modify their construction to conform to the proper clearances. A review of the options before may reduce or eliminate a hardship for the customer after construction is completed.

Please include the attached letter in your construction application process. We will also be sending it to your construction official and township engineer. Please do not hesitate to contact your Area Manager, if you have any additional questions. Thank you for your assistance.
