

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING THE
DONATION OF POLICE VEHICLES NUMBERS 991 AND
992 TO THE FLANDERS FIRST AID SQUAD**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive has determined that police vehicles #991 and #992, both 1999 Ford Crown Victoria vehicles, are no longer needed for public purposes due to major mechanical failure and body and frame deterioration and wish to donate same to the Flanders First Aid Squad for member training in emergency vehicle accident procedures; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36(2) provides that such personal property may be sold to another governmental unit or quasi governmental unit in the United States by private sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Police vehicles #991 and #992 are hereby declared to be surplus, no longer needed for public purposes; and
2. It is hereby authorized to donate police vehicles #991 and #992 to the Flanders First Aid Squad for their purpose.
