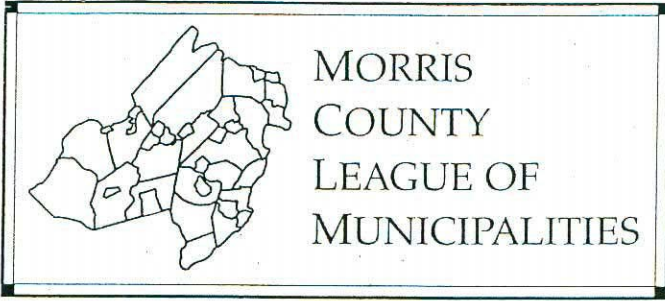

I-287 North to I-80 West via Exit 41B toward Delaware Water Gap

Take the Howard Boulevard North exit, Exit 30, toward Mt. Arlington

Turn slight right on to Howard Boulevard (CR 615)

In 1.3 miles, turn left on to Oneida Avenue

After approximately half a mile, turn right on to Mt. Arlington Boulevard
(CR 616)

Turn slight left on to Bertrand Island Road (Bertrand Island Road becomes
South Bertrand Road)

After half a mile, turn right on to Oak Street.

Then turn left on to North Bertrand Road.
