




Re: I. Fiscal Year 2011 US EPA Brownfield Grant RFP Announced!

EPA has released the FY2011 Brownfields Assessment, Revolving Loan Fund and Cleanup Grant Guidelines - Request for Proposals.

From the EPA web site: These grants may be used to address sites contaminated by petroleum and hazardous substances, pollutants, or

contaminants (including hazardous substances co-mingled with petroleum). Opportunities for funding are as follows: Brownfields Assessment Grants (each funded up to \$200,000 over three years; coalitions are funded up to \$1,000,000 over three years), Brownfields Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) Grants (each funded up to \$1,000,000 over five years) and Brownfields Cleanup Grants (each funded up to \$200,000 over three years). The proposal deadline is October 15, 2010.
