

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF MOUNT OLIVE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PASSAIC
VALLEY SEWERAGE COMMISSION FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SLUDGE**

WHEREAS, the Township of Mount Olive in connection with an operation of its sanitary treatment facilities needs to dispose of sludge and need to do so in a fashion that complies with environmental laws; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received a proposal as well as an agreement from the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission to permit the Township to dispose of its sludge at the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission's facility; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended the execution of the agreement which contains reasonable clauses for the purpose of disposing of sludge; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-10(a)(2), provides the Township with the ability to enter into a joint agreement for sludge disposal services and therefore the Township does not have to formally bid this service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Unit Pay-to-Play, any contract with a New Jersey governmental agency is exempt from the law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive that it does hereby authorize an agreement between the Township of Mount Olive and Passaic Valley Sewerage Commission, a copy of which is on file with the Administration and the Township Council does specifically authorize the Mayor to execute the aforesaid agreement.
