**WHEREAS**, the Township duly advertised for bids on September 4, 2008 and bids were opened on September 17, 2008 and the following bid(s) were received and publicly opened:

**Datalux - \$25,325.00**

**WHEREAS**, although only one bid was received, the using Department Head / Staff and the Business Administrator have reviewed the bids and recommended award to the responding bidder since although the specifications could be bid by an manufacturer of equipment that performed the prescribed functions, the equipment is specialized with only one manufacturer who markets in this area; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract is to be awarded pursuant to the "Fair and Open" process as required under the Pay-to-Play legislation NJSA 19:44A-20.7; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has provided a certification that the funds for this purchase are available.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Olive, Morris County, that the bid of Datalux in the amount of \$25,325.00 in accordance the specifications dated September 4, 2008 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute the necessary contracts to implement this bid award.
