Dress: Play clothes are strongly recommended. We will be using various medium to create pictures and projects. Remember it is not the finished project that counts but the fun and experience the child has working on it. Keep in mind comfort and ease in dressing for bathroom visits.

We will inform each class of any allergies that a classmate may have so as to avoid snack containing that food or ingredient.
